Apart from classroom & laboratory contacts, the students also have regular discussions/debates with faculty members every week (during co curricular activities periods) regarding improvement in academic affairs. Many extra classes are engaged as required even on non-working days in order to improve the performance of students. In certain cases, the parents are also called for interaction. During interaction with brighter students positive suggestions do come forth from time to time and these are implemented.
